1. Before choosing a hosting path

Write the answers down. If nobody can answer these, that is the first infrastructure problem to solve.

- 01 Define a default hosting decision tree for common client workloads.
- 02 Record registrar, DNS, server, and backup ownership.
- 03 Separate production from recovery storage.
- 04 Document patching, monitoring, and incident ownership for VPS workloads.
- 05 Use repeatable migration runbooks.
- 06 Review client workloads before renewing oversized or outdated infrastructure.

2. Match the workload to a DotMoose path

VPS Client services that need operating-system control.

Dedicated Larger, sustained, or physically isolated workloads.

Backups Independent recovery storage in the client design.

Domains Registrar and DNS ownership kept documented.

Turn the checklist into a real hosting plan.
