1. Before choosing a hosting path

Write the answers down. If nobody can answer these, that is the first infrastructure problem to solve.

- 01 Record domain, DNS, hosting, WordPress admin, and billing ownership.
- 02 Confirm PHP/runtime requirements and plugin dependencies.
- 03 Set a backup schedule and restoration owner.
- 04 Document caching, cron, SMTP, and third-party integrations.
- 05 Use a migration checklist before DNS cutover.
- 06 Escalate plugin-heavy or demanding sites when shared hosting stops fitting.

2. Match the workload to a DotMoose path

WordPress hosting The default path for many WordPress client sites.

cPanel hosting A familiar control plane for teams managing conventional sites.

VPS For sites needing server-level control or isolated resources.

Migrations Files, databases, DNS, certificates, and rollback together.
